The Government took more serious preventive measures after the first cases of contamination on Rwandan territory appeared.

Country effectively lock down. The situation is deteriorating day by day.

In our country everyday scene has been changing. Corona Pandemic changes all of our life. As far we know coming next two weeks will be very vulnerable for all of us.

Everyday thinking situation will be change but getting new information about risk.

Last night I have heard that one garment workers is affected in Chittagong. I need to recheck it.

But if it's happened that it will be a disaster. Because they live in high density area and worked in high density place. Our government & owner closed all institute school, office, court, transport but not close garment factory. Now after many drama from owner's side many factories are closed but few are still open. The fear is there.

Total died 20 today identified 54 and total identified 218. May be today the number will increase.

Here one of my writing that I started early but published on 6th April.

Risk of social isolation and greater health crisis.

I've attached a support card that we are using now and some photos. If you want you can share this with my writings to your links, friends and well wishers.

Our garment workers & working class people are in more danger then any middle class though corona has no class biasness. We from our garment workers organization trying to reach workers family who are in worse situation.

Gradually everyone is now close to the danger line. In the meantime we reach near about 1000 family with our support of Mask, soap, sanitizer & food. Now the stage is no more for Mask, sanitizer & soap. So we are trying to send food to the family or sent them money as they can buy themselves what they need. Sometimes it's difficult to send food for lock down and health issue. But we are trying our best. We are trying to avoid any kind of gathering or contact but working class people are always live in gathering.

So we are trying to aware all of our member about how to save them with precaution.

And now the necessity come to HELP people with food and health support.

We are working on these things. THANKS again for being with us.
